








Course Content

The Course Content feature contains learning modules for the course including text, links to other pages, and possibly video and audio recordings. Since it is up to your faculty to decide what to actually name this feature, you may see it listed as Modules, Lessons, Chapters, Units, etc.

Accessing Contents

1. Select the “Content Module” or “Modules” button from your WebCT homepage.
2. Select the module/content page you would like to view.
 - If the next page is a Table of Contents, proceed to step 3 below.
 - If the next page is a page of content, skip step 3 below.
3. Select the document you want to view from the Table of Contents.
4. Use the icons at the top of the screen to navigate through the content section.
 - The chart icon  allows you to return to the Table of Contents.
 - The left arrow  allows you to move back one page.
 - The right arrow  allows you to move forward to the next page.
 - The left double  arrows allow you to move back one page according to your previous path through the materials.
 - The down arrow  refreshes the page.
5. Select hyperlinks located to the right of the icons allow you to jump directly to another WebCT feature.
 - For example, the “Discussions” link allows you to go to the Notes topic in Discussions. You may then change to any discussion topic.
 - The hyperlinks will vary depending on what your faculty selected.



Faculty vary in the way content is organized. When you click the button for course content, you may find a Table of Contents listing all the content pages. Another format frequently used is to group content pages under buttons/hyperlinks that release part of the content. The faculty then release the various parts of content throughout the term.
